# REQUIREMENTS FOR INDIVIDUAL BOARDS & COMMISSIONS of the CITY OF NEWBERRY

## I. Architectural Review Board (5 members):

- ✓ Must live in the City.
- ✓ Demonstrated interest in historic preservation.
- ✓ Meet the six-hour state orientation requirement and three hours per year continuing education requirement.
- ✓ Be able to meet at 9AM on the third Thursday of the month.

#### II. Accommodations Tax Advisory Commission (7 members):

- ✓ Must live in the City
- ✓ Must be employed in the hospitality industry (restaurant, lodging, etc.)

## III. Housing Authority Board (7 members):

- ✓ Must live in the City
- ✓ One Board member must be a Housing Authority resident

#### IV. Planning Commission (7 members):

- ✓ Must live in the City.
- ✓ Demonstrated interest in the planned growth of the City.
- ✓ Meet the six-hour state orientation requirement and three hours per year continuing education requirement.
- ✓ Be able to meet at 5PM on the third Monday of the month.

#### V. Miss Newberry Scholarship Organization (7 members):

- ✓ Be a resident of Newberry County or employed by Newberry College
- ✓ Prior Experience with the Miss South Carolina and/or Miss America Organization Scholarship Organizations or like scholarship programs for teen and young adult females
- ✓ Be able to attend meetings regularly when scheduled to support requirements to maintain standing within the Miss South Carolina Scholarship Organization – both locally and at State level
- ✓ Must be willing to put forth time, talent and token on behalf of the MNSO
- Must be vetted by the MNSO Board Members and recommended to Council for appointment

## VI. Zoning Board of Appeals (5 members):

- ✓ Must live in the City.
- ✓ Meet the six-hour state orientation requirement and three hours per year continuing education requirement.
- ✓ Be able to meet at 10AM on the fourth Wednesday of the month.

#### VII. Construction Board of Appeals (5 members):

- ✓ Meets on an as needed basis.
- ✓ Demonstrated interest in the construction or building codes industry.

## VIII. Newberry Opera House Foundation Board (17 members):

- ✓ To be vetted by NOHF Board members and recommended to City Council for appointment.
- ✓ Must be willing to put forth time, talent and token on behalf of the NOH.
